- Have you been accepted as a full-time student at an accredited institution?Accredited institution is a college, university, or technical

- Degrees or trade training like HVAC, plumbing, electrical, or degrees like engineering (mechanical, civil, construction), operations management, and horticulture would fit this requirement.
